ROOFING SPECIFICATIONS

General

The Greystone Estates South Declaration of Restrictions requires that re-roofing materials be approved by the Homes Association. Where re-roofing consists of wood shingles or shakes comparable to the initial roof and applied consistent with Lenexa building codes, approval can be given quickly upon receipt of a roofing request. Where the homeowner plans to use an alternative roofing material, the following specifications will apply and the roofing request must be approved by the Homes Association prior to start of construction.

Alternative Roofing Material Specifications

- Existing shingles or shakes must be removed and roof slats covered with 1/2 inch or thicker exterior grade plywood or comparable material.
- 30 pound or heavier felt paper must be used as underlayment.
- Galvanized roofing nails with a minimum of 1/2 inch "grab" are required.
- Roofing material must have Class A Fire rating and a minimum of 30 year manufacturers warranty.
- Shingle color is limited to that of weathered wood. Hues or colors other than the gray weathered wood appearance will not be approved.
- Roof valleys may be of the same roofing materials or metal. It metal is chosen, the color must be the same as the roofing material, i.e. weathered wood.
- Extra thick or double thickness shingles will require for roof ridges.

The roofing approval request must be completed by the homeowner and contractor and forwarded to the Homes Association Architectural Committee allowing reasonable time for approval prior to start of construction.

Except for the products and colors listed below, a sample of the planned roofing material must accompany the roofing approval request.

- GAF Timberline Ultra (40 year) Weathered Wood Blend Color
- GAF Timberline (30 year) Weathered Wood Blend Color
- Owens Corning Oakridge Shadow (40 year) Shale Color
- Owens Corning Oakridge (30 year) Shale Color
- Malarkey Legacy (50 year) Weathered Wood Color
- Elk Prestique Plus (40 year) Weathered Wood Color

Note: Other products with similar colors will be added to the above list as requests for such are approved and additional homework is completed with manufacturers.
